#### **Minutes**

- 1. <u>Previous Minutes:</u> Dwight moved the minutes be accepted, Jane seconded. Carried.
- 2. Outstanding Business

## a. Club Gala Day Planning Saturday 7th March 2020

Everything is organized. A decision will be made at 8am to cancel Juniors if the weather is unsuitable, this also allows for food (Subway and Woolworths) to be cancelled. Jackie will make the weather decision. A decision for Seniors will be made at 11.30am. Reminder that timing is tight and to try and keep organized so the Gala day finishes in time.

#### b. Moly Cop Shirts

Stock has been handed out. Awaiting 30 players to provide sizing. If sizing is not given by Saturday, sizing will be estimated for remaining players. First order (52 shirts) has been sent to company. Men's and kids shirts have arrived. A total of 115 shirts will be ordered (total players). Male playing singlets for mixed and junior teams have been organized and can be ordered as required.

#### d. Team Selection and Pre-Season Training Report

Well attended including Juniors. Positive feedback including from players and outside community. Players reported a feeling of community and gave new players to the club an opportunity to get to know people prior to the selection games. Need multiple senior coaches- one week with only two senior coaches was challenging. Cheryl Hernando attended as third party, assisting in selections and selection day. All agreed to do again next year.

## 4. Reports

#### a. Treasurer's Report

i. <u>Finance Report</u>: At the end of February we had \$10,147 in the bank. This is \$10k below what I had predicted. However, I had expected to pay \$16k of registrations and court fees in March, where as we have paid those fees in February. We are currently \$1,195 below the whole year budget for registration revenue. However, we have \$2,350 in unpaid rego fees, which when paid, will see us come in higher than budget. The rego costs to NNA (& court lights) are above budget by \$291, so the net of the registrations will see us better than budget by \$2,051. I do expect that the addition registration will cost us more in equipment over the year and at the end of the year function. I note that we have only spent half of the budgeted \$5k from Molycop. As we have only received half, I suggest we consider what we will buy but order after we receive the second half of the Molycop money.

ii. Outstanding fees: ~20 players with outstanding registration fees. 3 people on payment plans, the rest have not approached regarding payment plans. Dwight to organize with coaches contacting players. All agreed without full payment or a payment plan organised, the player cannot take the court.

iii. <u>Budget Policy Statement:</u> Dwight proposed policy was not necessary as current spreadsheet reflects a repeatable budget. All agreed.

## b. Registrar's Report

i. <u>Registration Update:</u> As at 6.30pm of 5th March 2020, Waratah Netball Club had 125 members on the MyClubMate system. These included 10 members of the Inner Glow Waratah 23s who, although registered via MyNetball as a separate independent team, are maintained on our register for tracking purposes.

In 2019 we had 105 members on the database.
